


BOWL REFRESH SODA

Freshen up your toilet—without the fuss.





CLOGGED DRAIN DESTROYER

A simple solution for a backed up drain.



Directions

1. Mix 1 cup ARM & HAMMER™ Baking Soda and ¼ cup citric acid together in a bowl.
2. Add 20 drops of your favorite essential oil and mix.
3. Mist the powder with water and mix.
4. Repeat until you've sprayed 10-12 times, mixing after every 2 sprays.
5. Press the mixture into a silicone mold, firmly pressing the corners and sides.
6. Let dry overnight, or about 12 hours.
7. Carefully pop out your toilet bombs into an airtight bag or container away from kids and pets.
8. Drop into the toilet and watch the magic happen!

Ingredients

- 1 cup ARM & HAMMER™ Baking Soda
- ¼ cup citric acid
- 10-12 ounces water
- 20 drops of your favorite essential oil
- Silicone molds
- Spray bottle

Directions

1. Pour a pot of nearly boiling, hot water down your sink drain.
2. Dump in about ½ cup ARM & HAMMER™ Baking Soda and let sit for 3-5 minutes.
3. Pour a mixture of 1 cup white vinegar and 1 cup very hot water down the drain.
4. Let this mixture let sit for 5-10 minutes.

BATHTUB SUPER SCRUB

Baking soda sends water stains down the drain.



Directions

1. Sprinkle 1 cup ARM & HAMMER™ Baking Soda around your bathtub, layering more onto stains and other marks.
2. Mix 1 cup white vinegar and 1 cup warm water in a spray bottle and spray on the baking soda, letting the mixture bubble for 5-10 minutes.
3. Scrub the mixture with a soft bristle

- brush until a paste forms.
4. Let the paste sit for 15 minutes, then wipe away with a sponge and rinse with water.



SHOWER HEAD SHINE

Break down all that build-up!



FOR POLISHED METAL FIXTURES, AVOID USING AN ABRASIVE SPONGE OR BRUSH—YOU COULD RISK DAMAGING THE SURFACE.

Directions

1. Mix 1/3 cup ARM & HAMMER™ Baking Soda with 1 cup white vinegar in a gallon-sized resealable bag.
2. Secure the bag over your dirty shower head with a rubber band, making sure it is completely submerged.
3. Leave the bag on the shower head for several hours or overnight.

4. Remove the bag, wipe down the shower head with a rag or sponge and run hot water.
5. Enjoy your sparkling clean shower head!

Ingredients

- 1/3 cup ARM & HAMMER™ Baking Soda
- 1 cup white vinegar
- 1 gallon resealable bag
- Rubber bands
- Rag or sponge


HARDWARE POLISHING PASTE

It's time to get your shine on!

VS



FOR TOUGH STAINS
APPLY BLEACH LIKE OXICLEAN
AND RINSE WITH CLEAN
WATER SO DIRT DOESN'T
RESETTLE INTO GROUT LINES.



Directions

1. Scrub your grout lines with plain warm water and a stiff bristle brush. Let the area sit until completely dry.
2. Spray the area with a mixture of 1 cup white vinegar and 1 cup warm water. Let sit for 5 minutes and scrub.
3. Apply a paste of ¾ cup ARM & HAMMER™ Baking Soda and ¼ cup

- water, then spray with the previous vinegar mixture.
4. Once the mixture stops foaming, scrub with your brush and rinse with plain water.
5. Optional: Add hydrogen peroxide to remove any remaining dirt.

Ingredients

- ¾ cup ARM & HAMMER™ Baking Soda
- 1 cup white vinegar
- Warm water
- Spray bottle
- Stiff bristle brush
- Optional: Hydrogen peroxide
- Optional: Bleach, such as OxiClean

Directions

1. Mix ¾ cup ARM & HAMMER™ Baking Soda with ¼ cup distilled water to make a paste that you can form with your hand, but is still wet enough to spread.
2. Spread the paste on your fixtures and let sit for 15-20 minutes.
3. Use a microfiber cloth to wipe the paste away, applying gentle pressure as you go.

- ¾ cup ARM & HAMMER™ Baking Soda
- Distilled water
- Microfiber cloth
